

YOU CRACK ME UP LAYOUT

Materials you'll need:

Pilot Frixion Ball pens	Paper
Sellotape Double-Sided tape	Cardstock
Sellotape Sticky Dots	Letters
Sellotape Photo Dots	Chipboard shape
Sellotape Foam Pads	and journalling spots
Westcott scissors	Pipe cleaner
Hole punch	Embroidery thread
	Paint

Instructions:

Step 1.

Paint the chipboard journalling spots and shape in your chosen colours and set aside to dry.

Step 2.

Freehand doodle two lines around the border of the cardstock background with a Frixion Ball pen. Then colour in random blocks within the border. Remember, it doesn't matter if you make a mistake as the Frixion Ball pens are erasable!

Step 3.

Using Westcott scissors cut a 6in x 6in piece of lined, patterned paper. Punch holes down one side and tear to replicate note paper. Adhere to cardstock with Sellotape Double-Sided tape 2¼ inches from the top left and 1¾ inches from the left hand side.

Step 4.

Using Westcott scissors cut a 6in x 4½in piece of coordinating patterned paper. Affix this with Sellotape Double-Sided tape 3 inches from the right side of the cardstock and 3½ inches down from the top, overlapping the first piece. Cut a 2in x 8in piece of patterned paper and adhere with Sellotape Double-Sided tape across the bottom of the layout, overlapping the first two pieces.

Step 5.

From the second piece of paper, cut a 1½in x 8in rectangle. Freehand draw scallops with a Pilot Frixion Ball pen, cut them out and affix with Sellotape Double-Sided tape slightly underneath the bottom piece of paper.

Step 6.

Place your 3½in x 2¾in photos on the background with Sellotape Photo Dots, tilting one slightly. Cut a length of pipe cleaner and sew it in place just above the scalloped piece of patterned paper.

Step 7.

Adhere the chipboard shape to the bottom left corner just beneath the photo using Sellotape Foam Pads. Affix the journalling spots to the right hand side of the page with Sellotape Double-Sided tape and Foam Pads. Doodle around the outside of the journalling spots, then write your journalling with a Pilot Frixion Ball pen.

Step 8.

Finally, add your title with mixed letters using Sellotape Double-Sided tape.

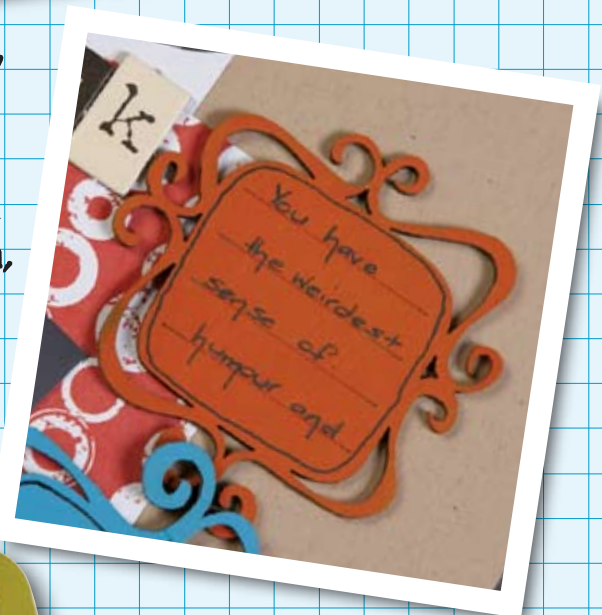
