

# personal styling: painted timber bangle



## What you'll need:

1. Sellotape Masking Tape General Purpose  
Available in 18mm, 24mm, 36mm and 48mm widths
2. Timber bangles  
Available from craft or hardware shops
3. Small paintbrush
4. Acrylic craft paints
5. Clear protective top coat



**TIP:** To paint the entire bangle, repeat steps 1 to 3, however this time apply masking tape to block out the painted areas, leaving the unpainted area exposed.

## What to do:

1. Cut lengths of the Masking Tape slightly wider than the bangle. Stick them onto the timber bangle to block out areas that are to remain unpainted.
2. Ensure edges of the tape are well adhered to prevent paint bleed underneath and to achieve sharp, clean paint edges.
3. Wet the brush sparingly with paint and fill in the unmasked areas.
4. Once all the unmasked areas have been painted and the paint is dry, carefully remove the masking tape.
5. Once the paint is dry, consider spraying the finished bangle with a clear protective top coat to preserve the paint job.
